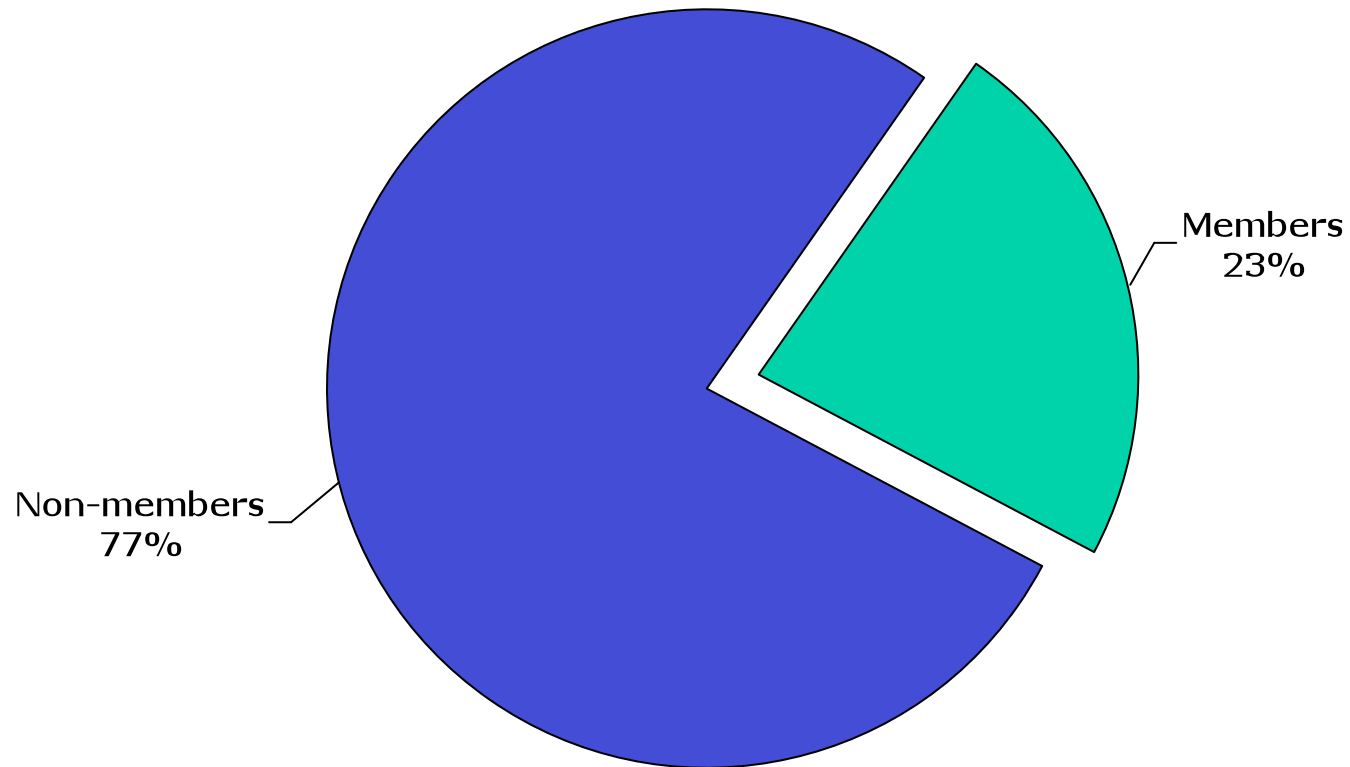


# Purpose of Questionnaire

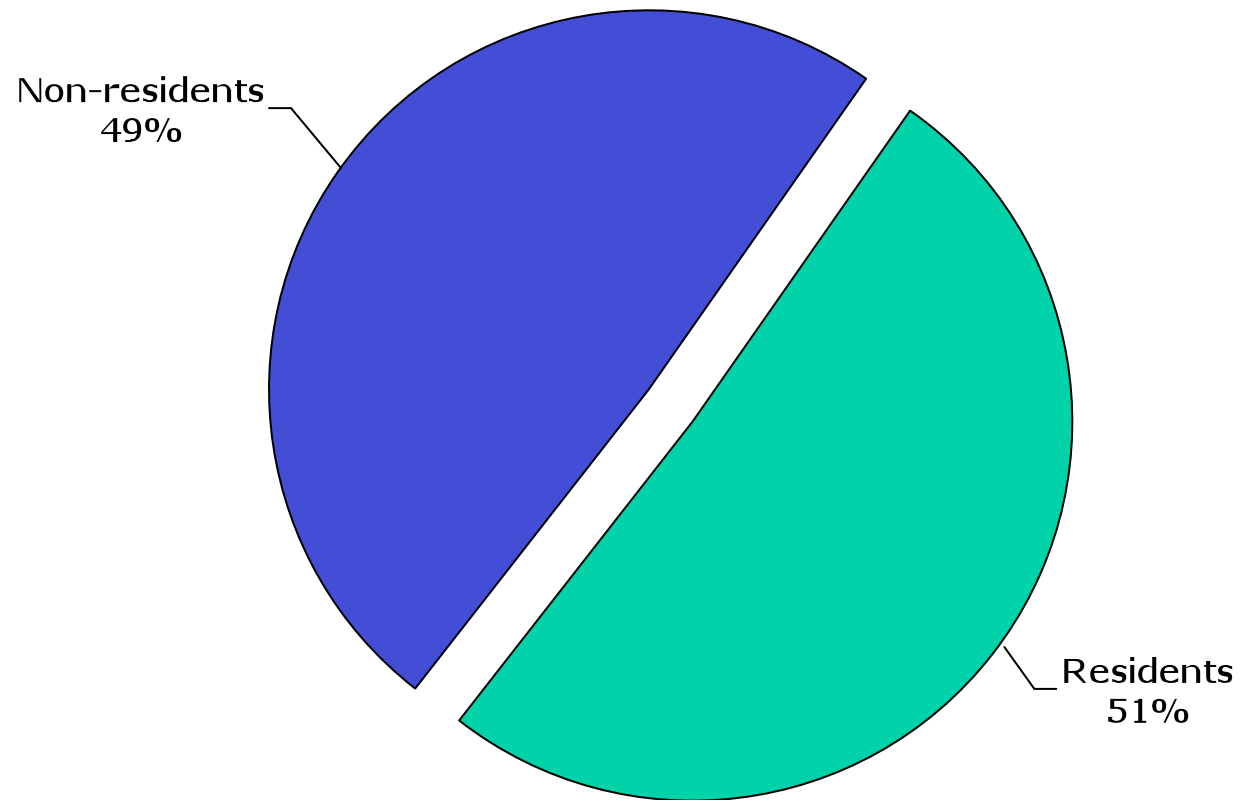
- Present proposals from feedback by Pride team

- 1280 responses received by closing date



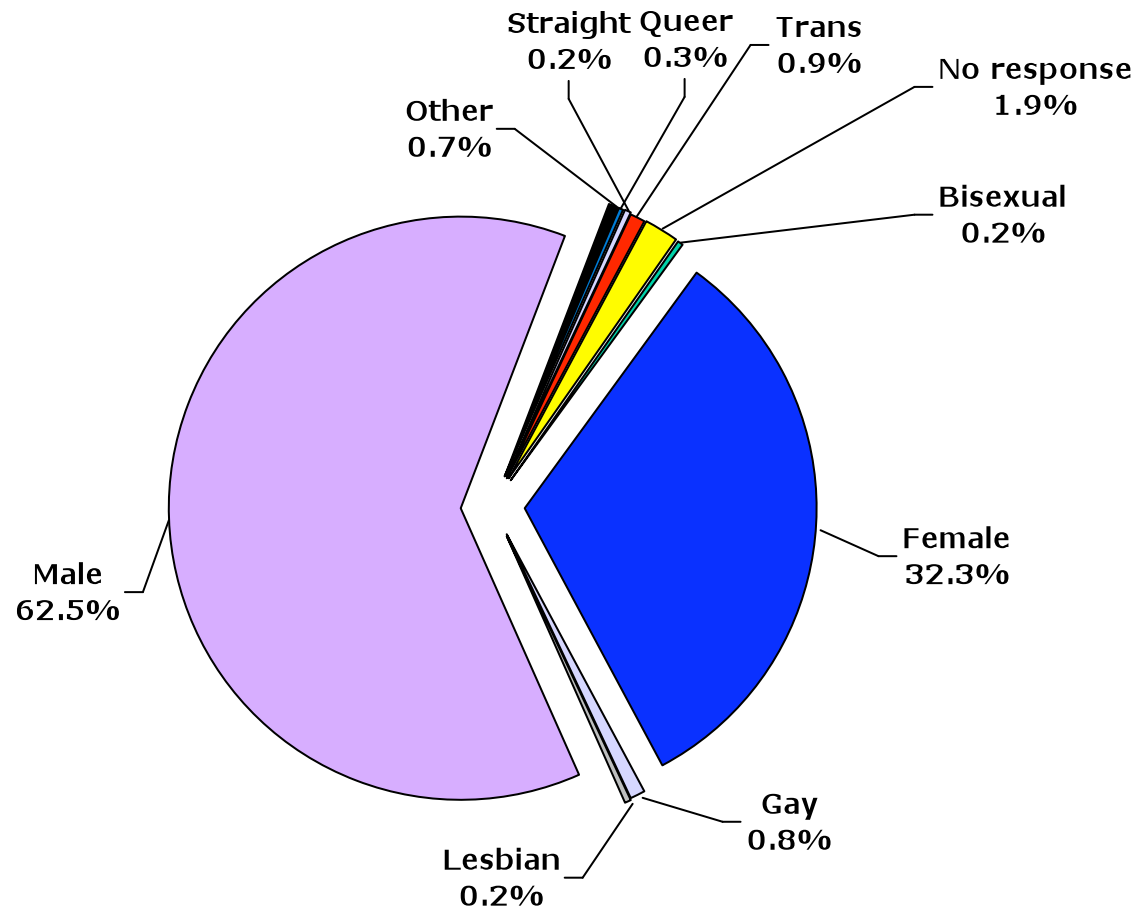

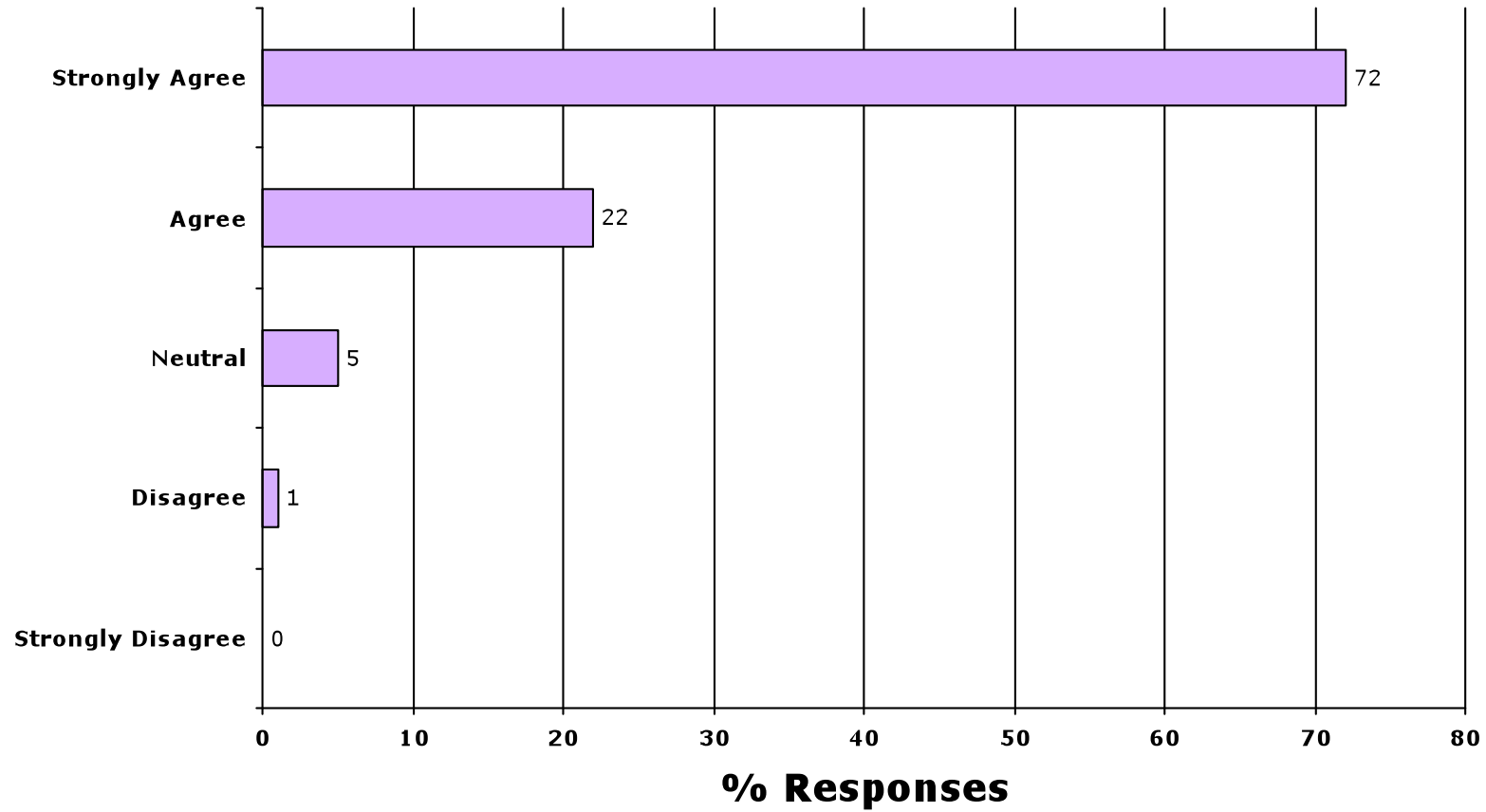
# Registered Charitable Objectives.



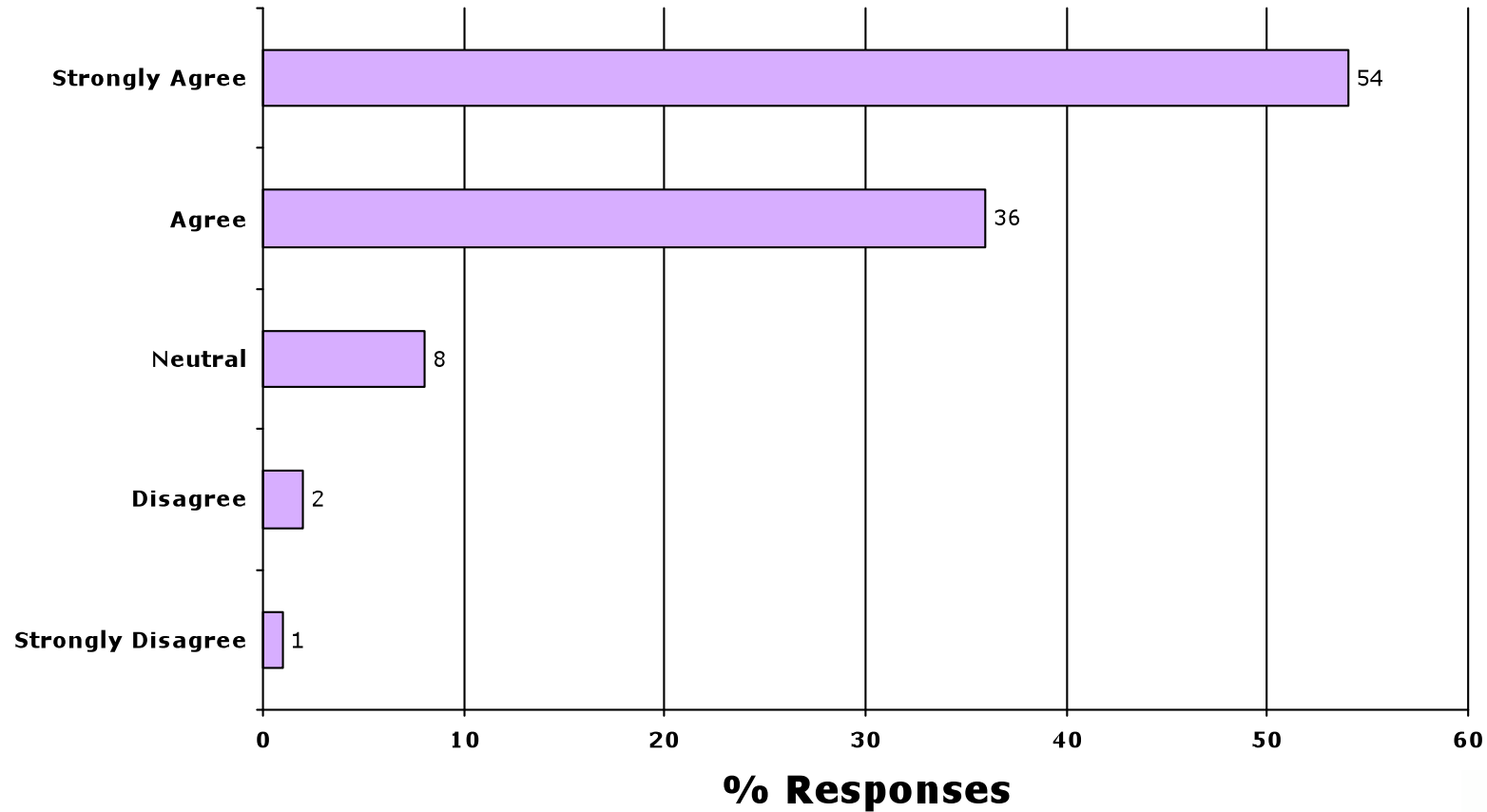
# Pride should use the Summer Festival, Parade and Main Park event as the key activities to deliver the charity's objectives.



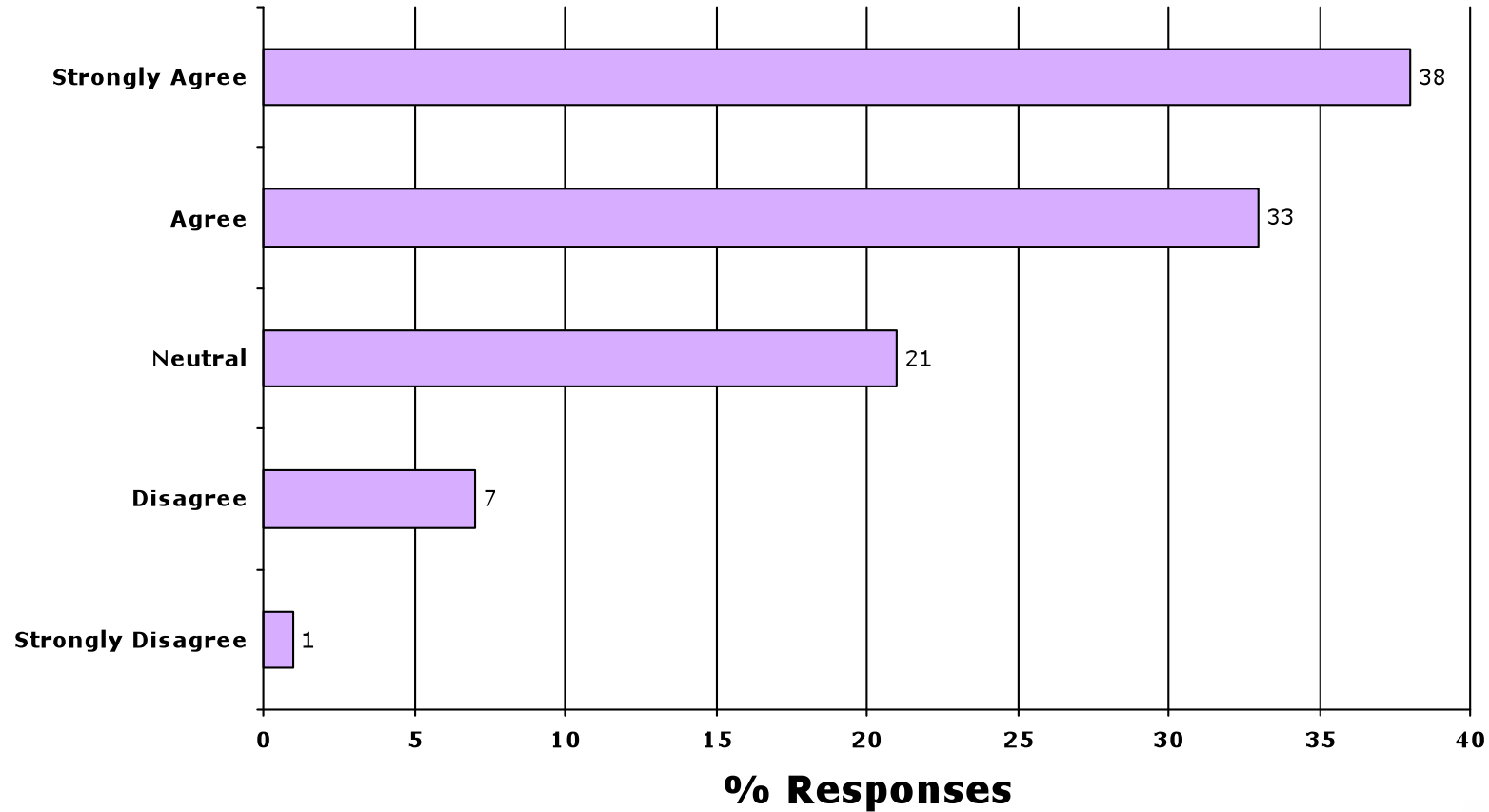
# Pride should organise and support an annual Pride Parade.



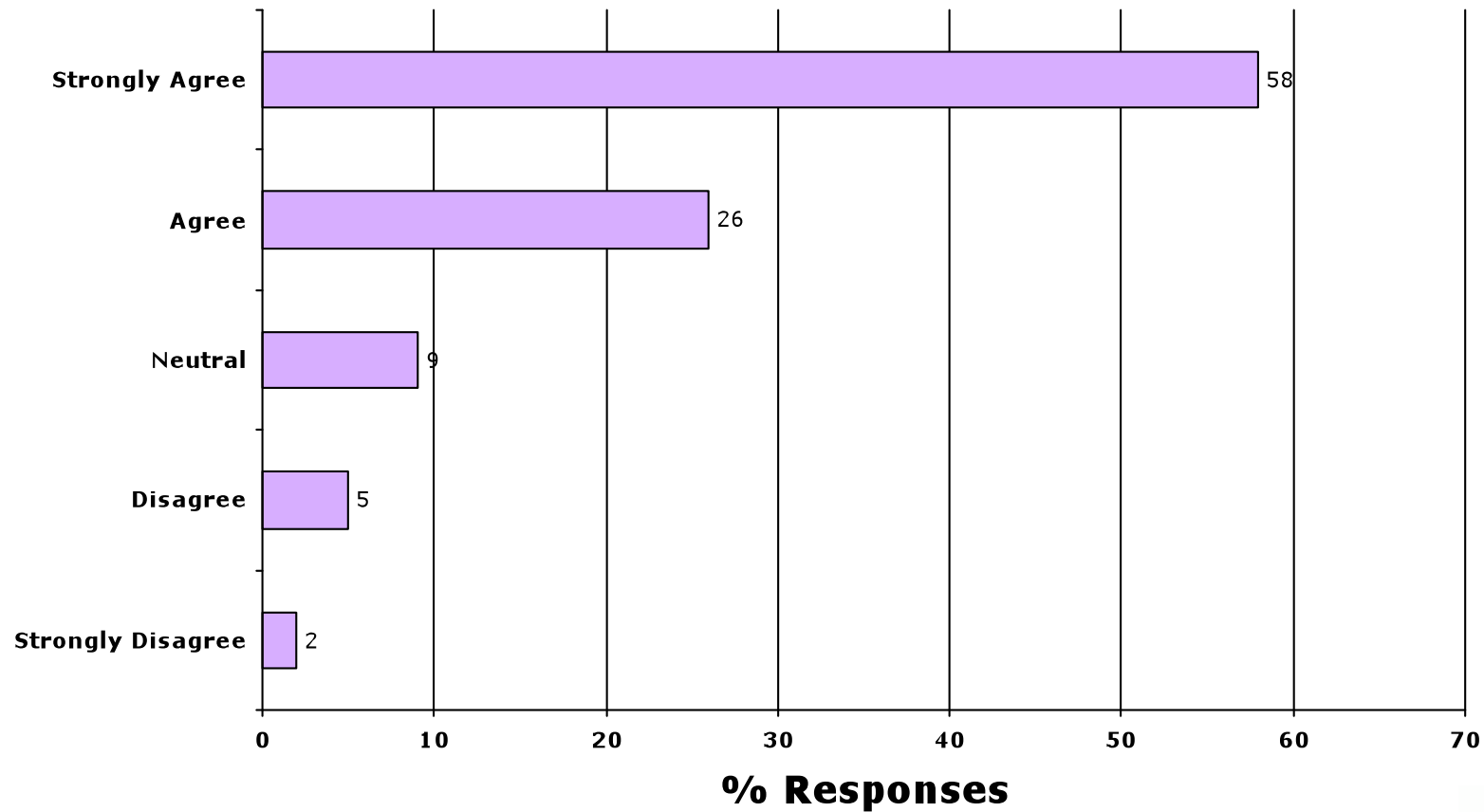
**Pride should seek to use existing resources, and find additional resources, to improve the way the Parade conveys key messages that support the charity's objectives.**



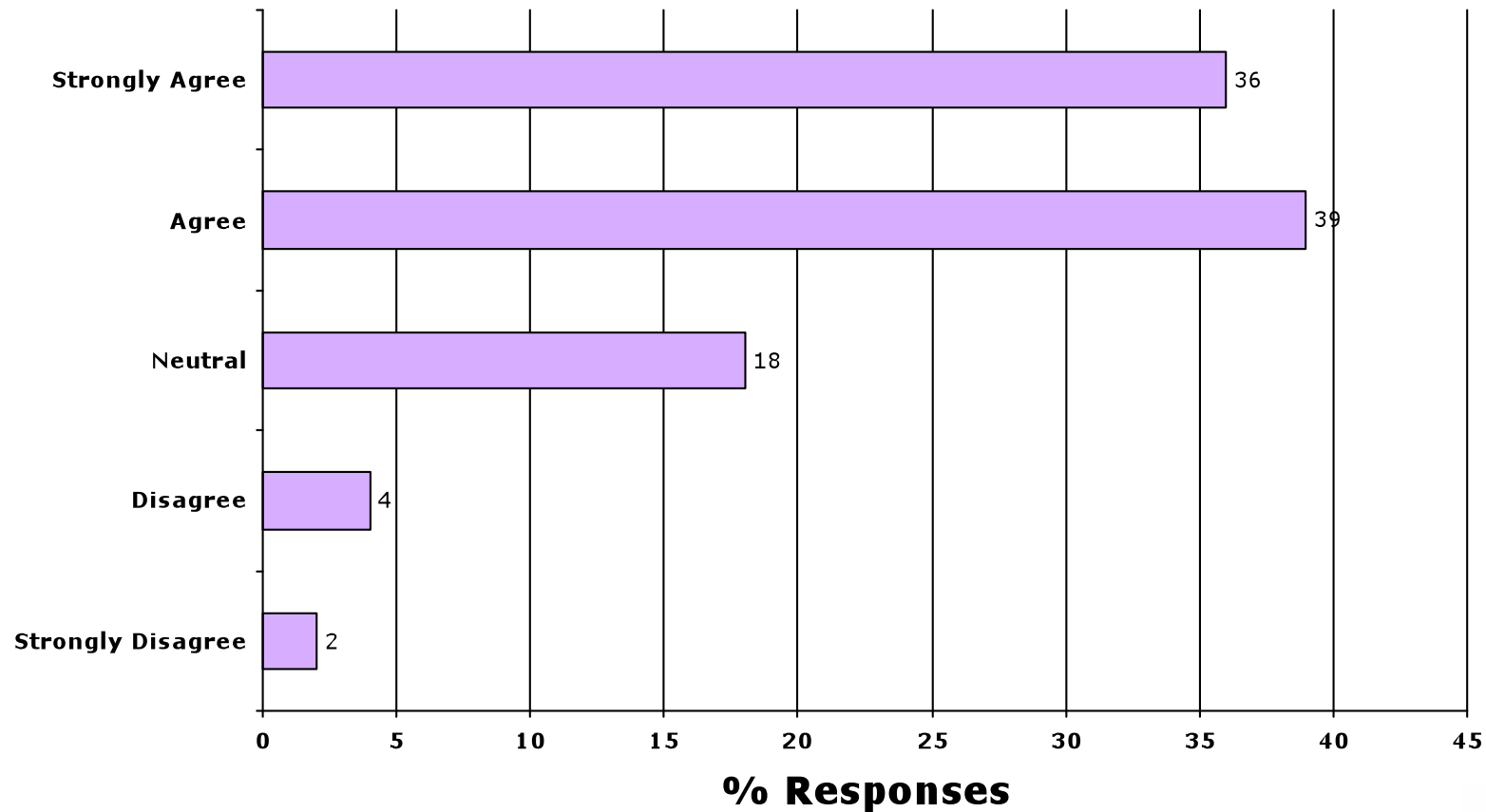
# Pride should seek to use existing resources, and find additional resources, to improve the artistic quality of the Parade.



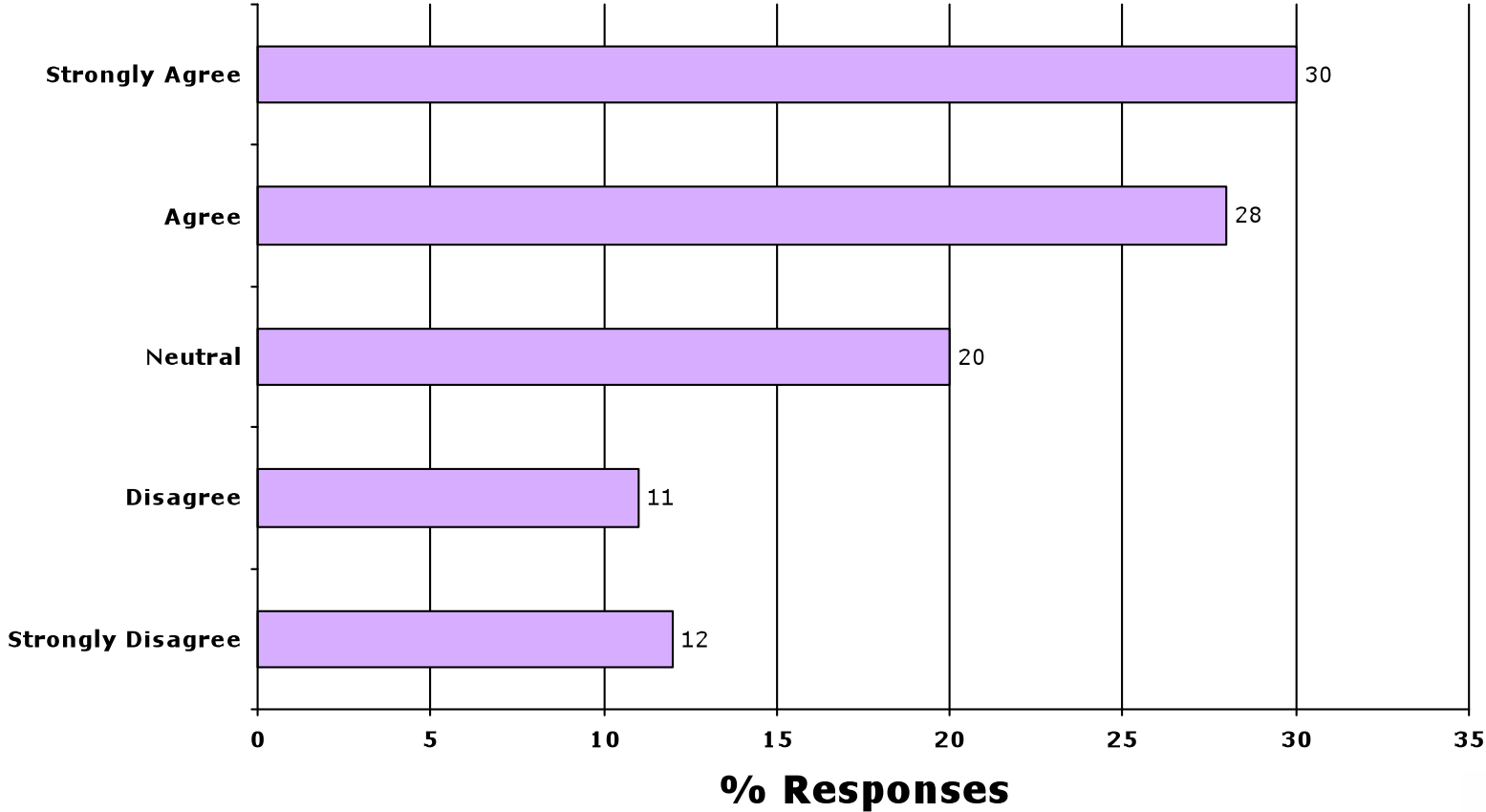
# Pride should organise an event in Preston Park that is open to everyone.



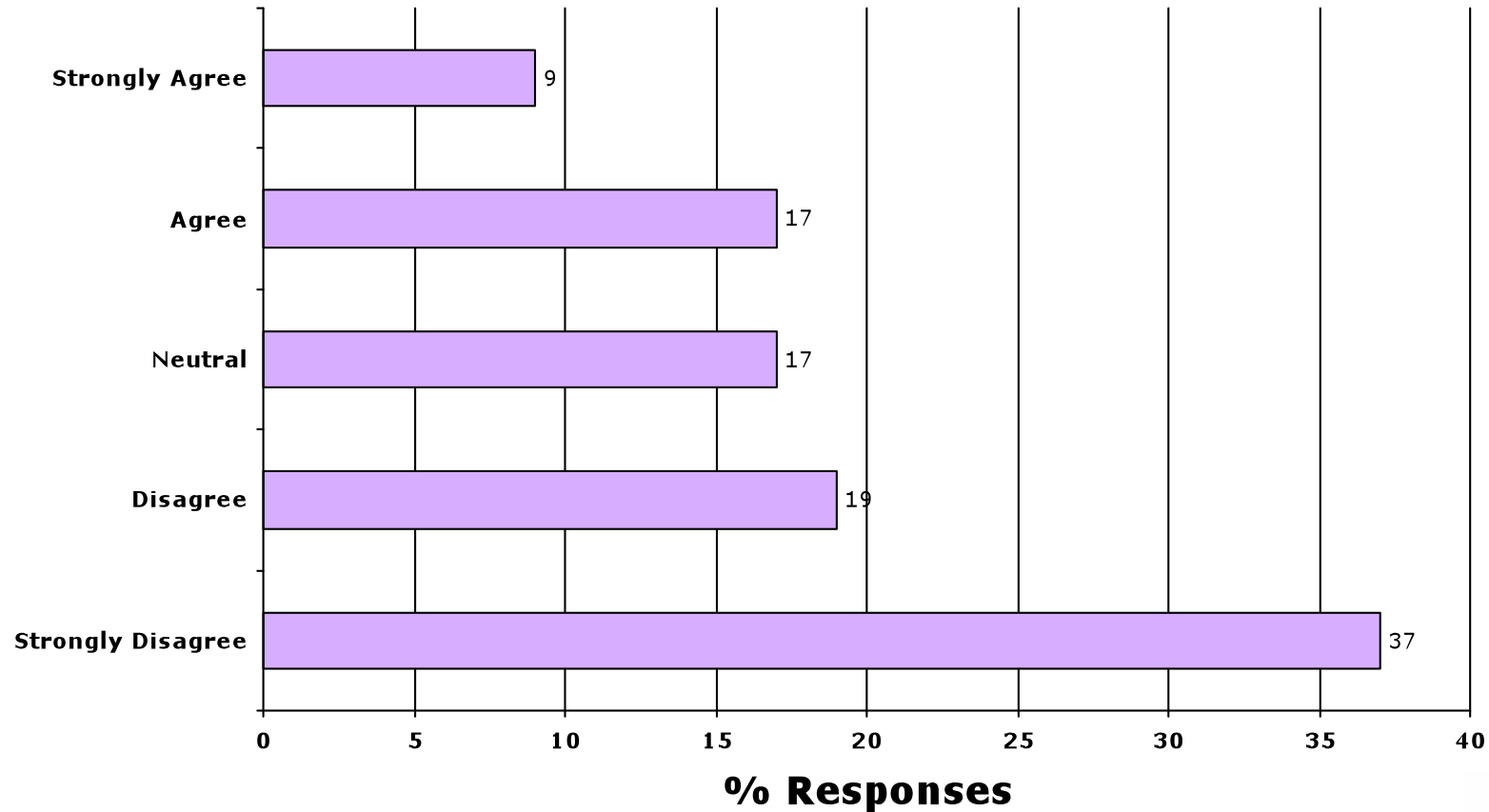
**Pride should directly support and fund the creation of a community 'heart of the park' area – to provide information stalls, community exhibitions and possibly link the Parade with the Main Park event.**



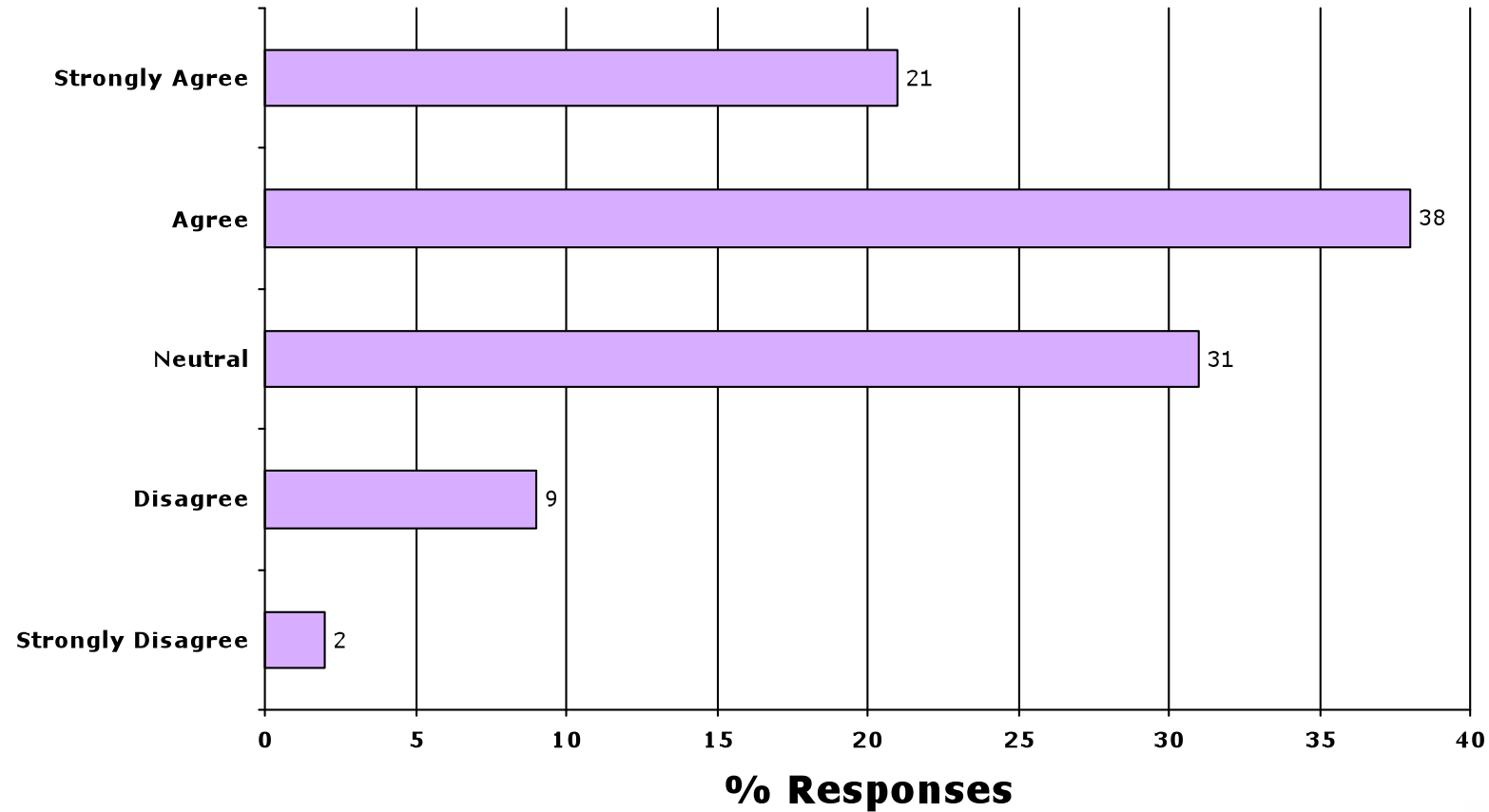
**Pride should directly support and fund three key entertainment areas – consisting of a performance tent, music tent and arts/cultural tent.**



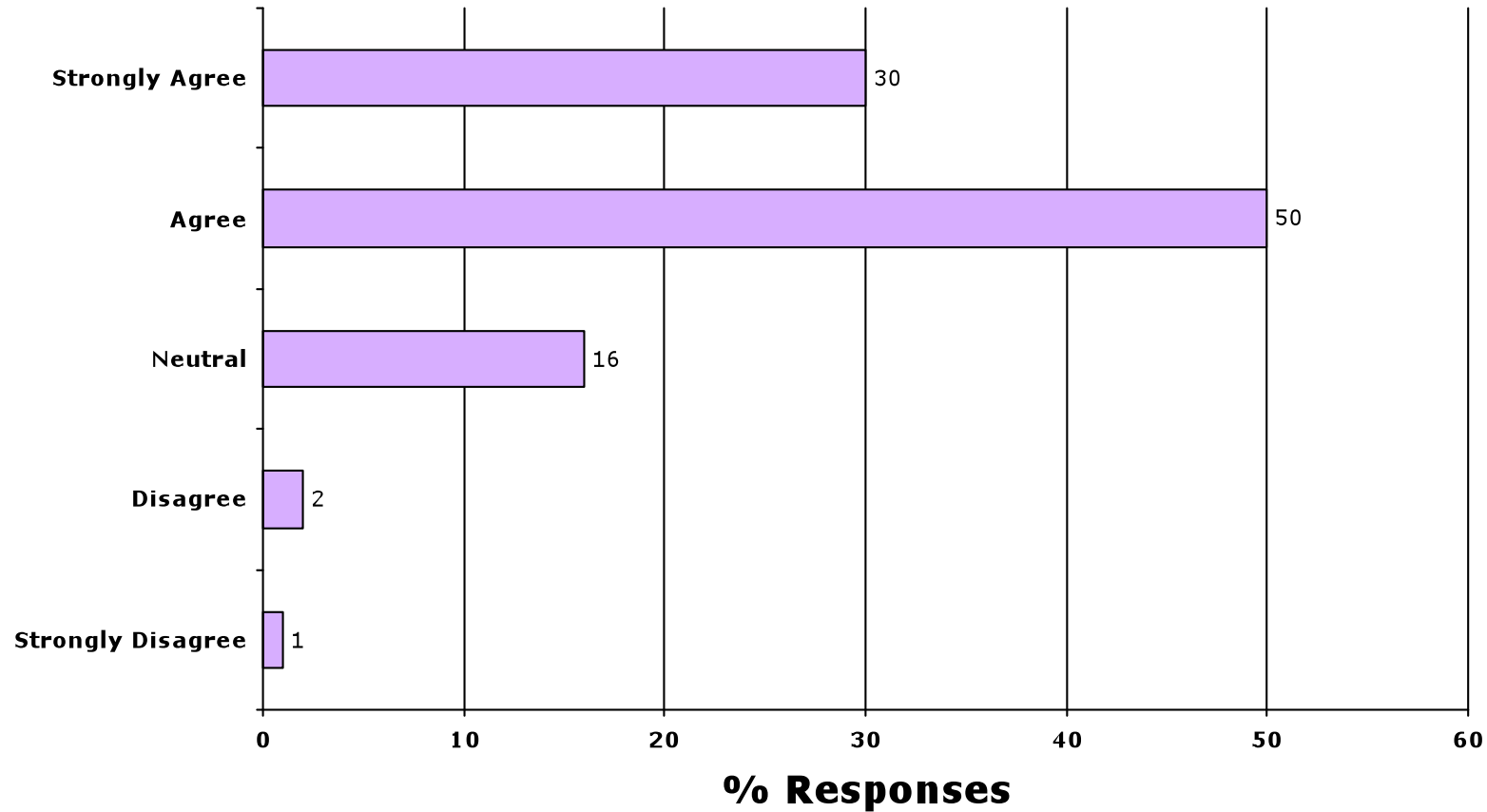
# **Pride should not encourage, support or fund all of the infrastructure, entertainment and dance tents and activities previously provided at the Main Park event.**



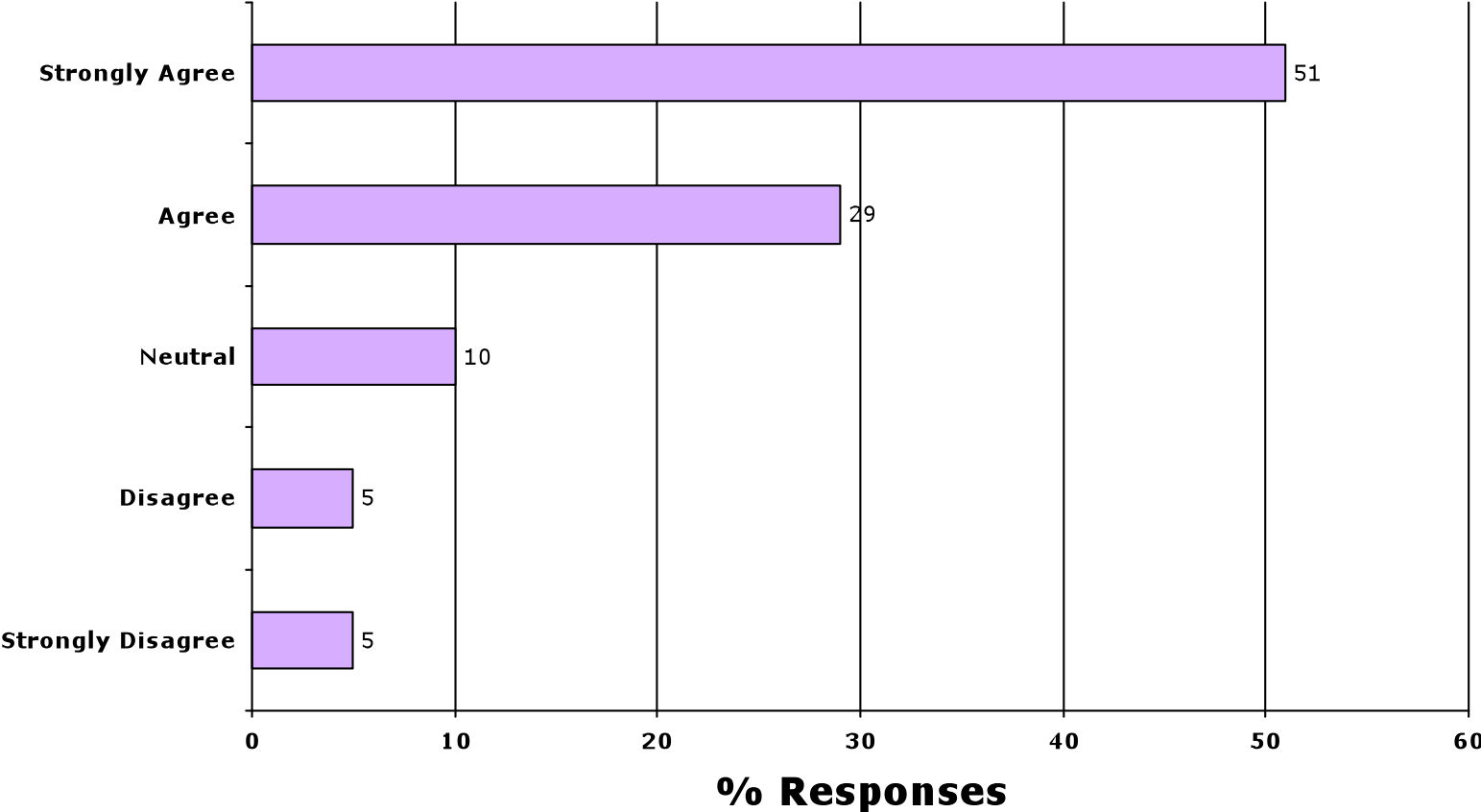
# Pride should directly support and fund LGBT sports/activities areas.



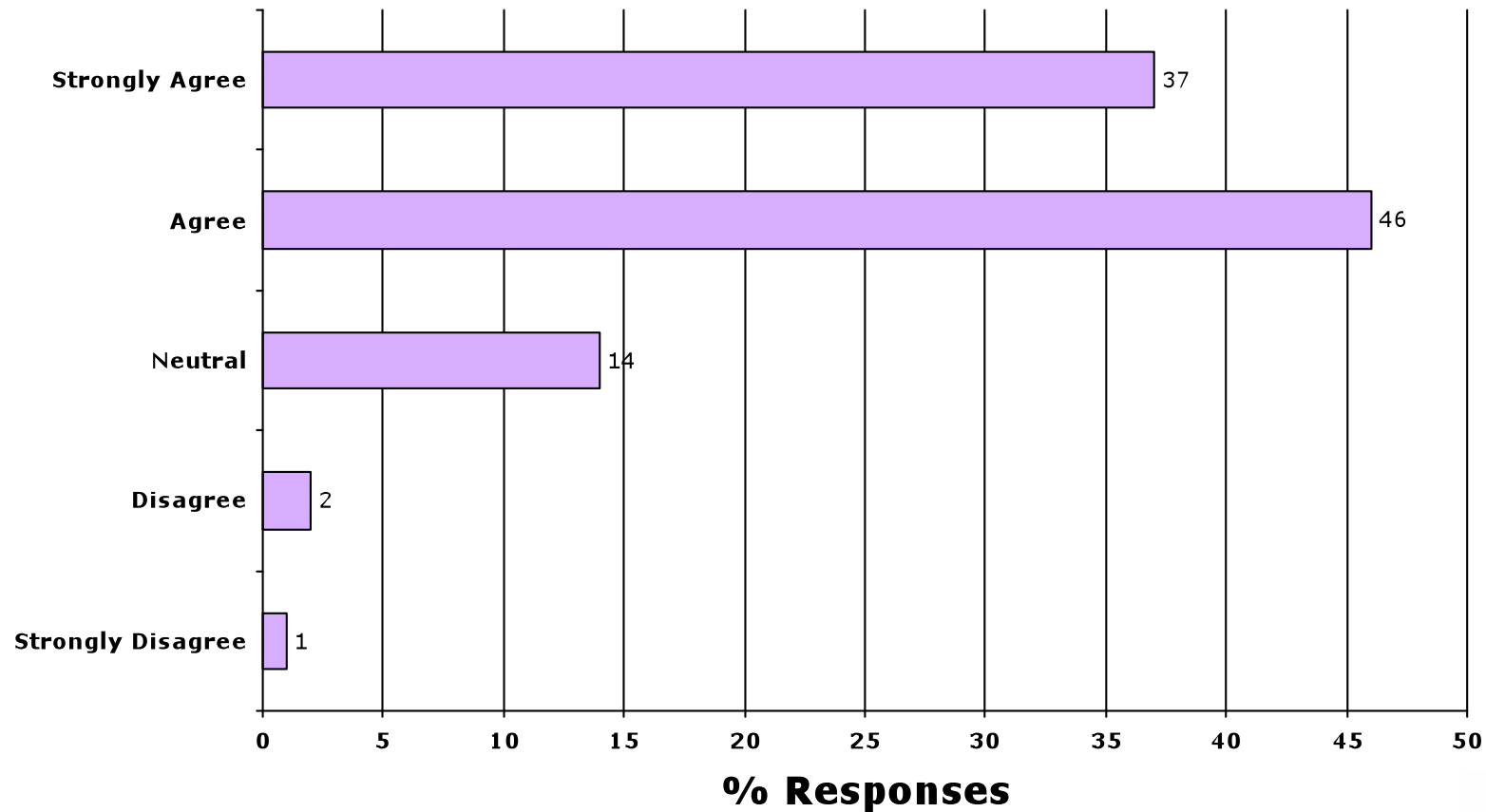
# Pride should provide space for an LGBT market traders' area.



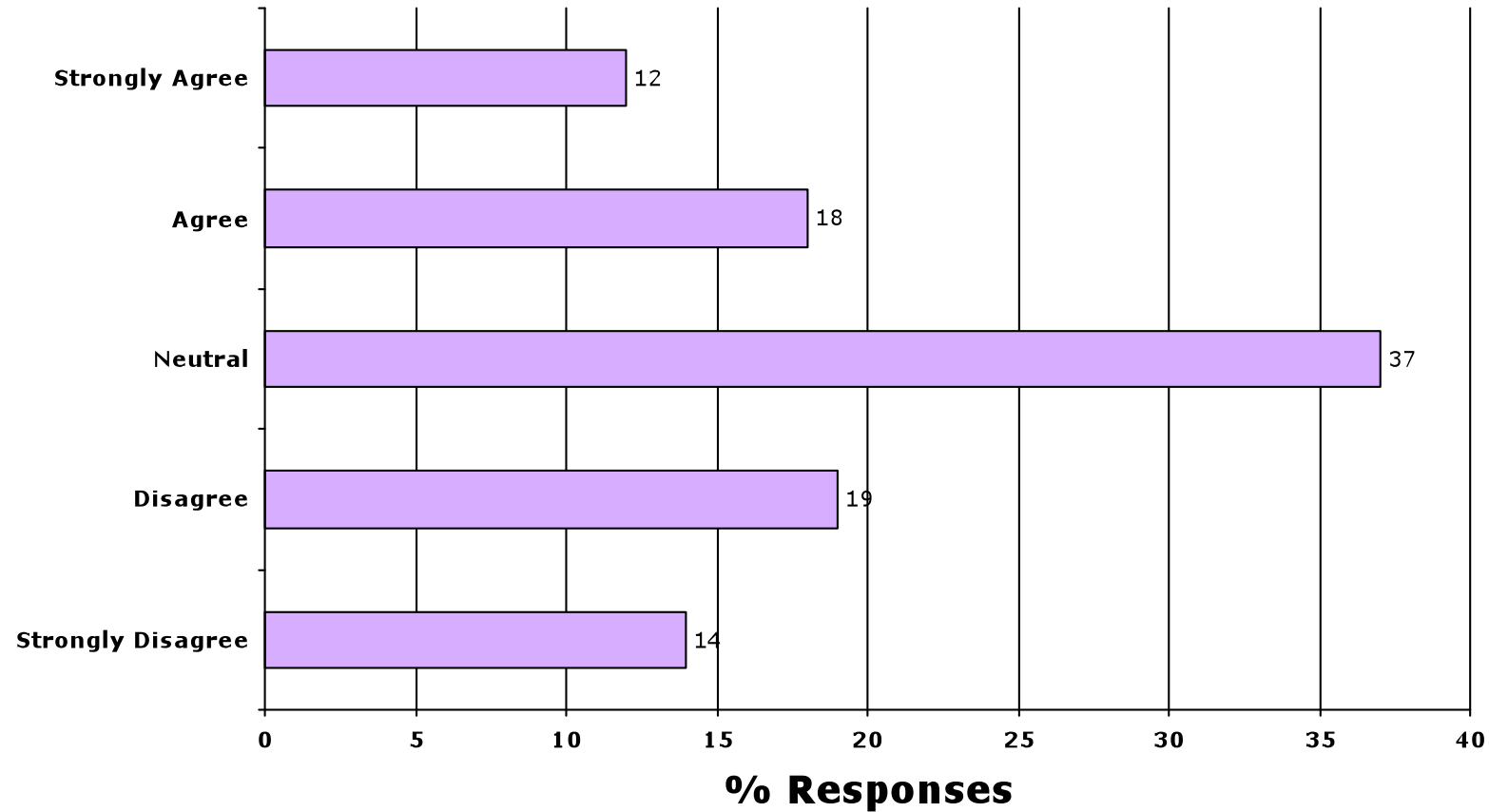
# Pride should encourage entry to the Main Park event by donation, at key entry points to the park.



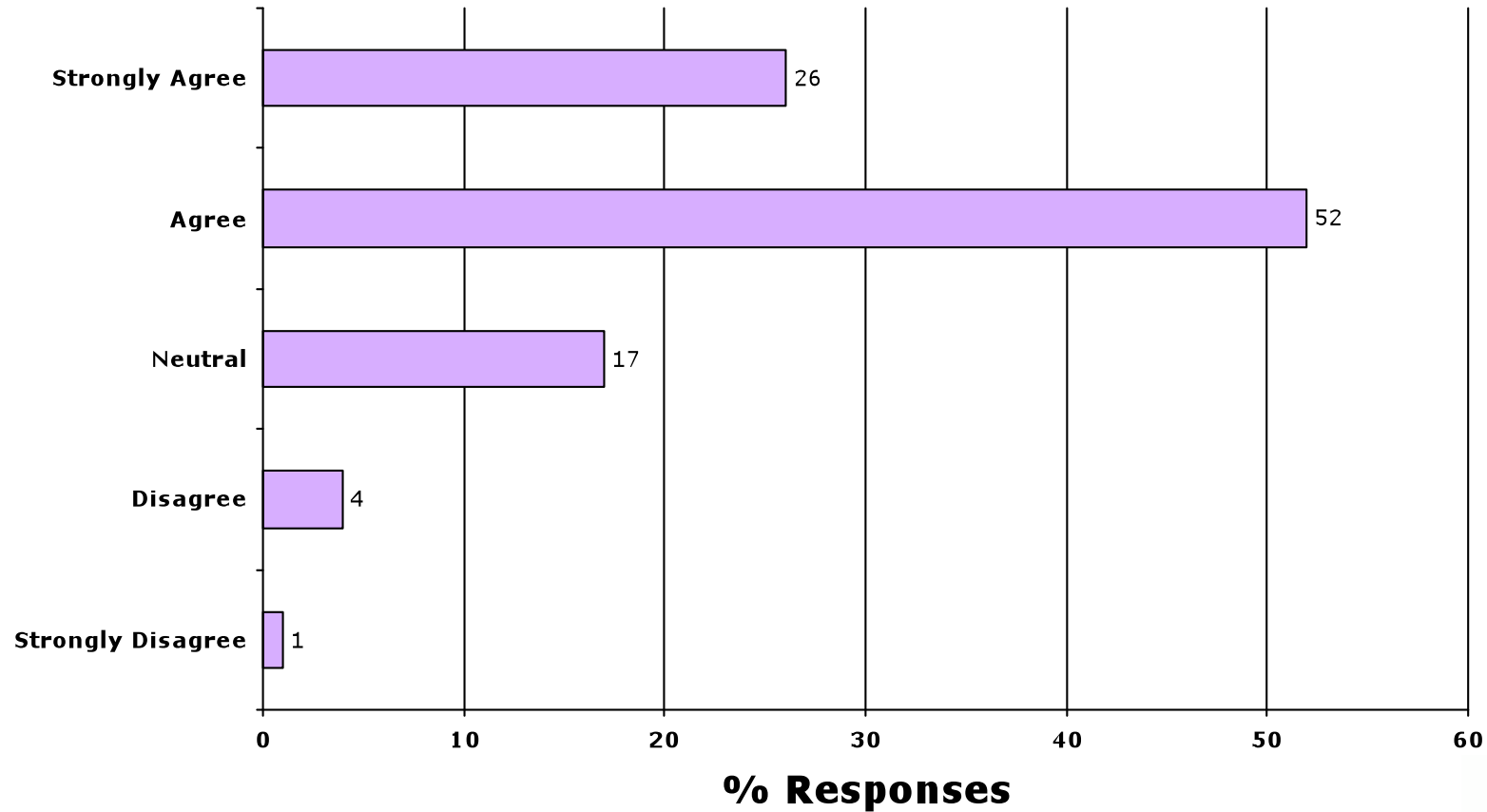
# Pride should co-ordinate and promote a Pride Summer Festival week with a range of events organised by LGBT community groups and businesses.



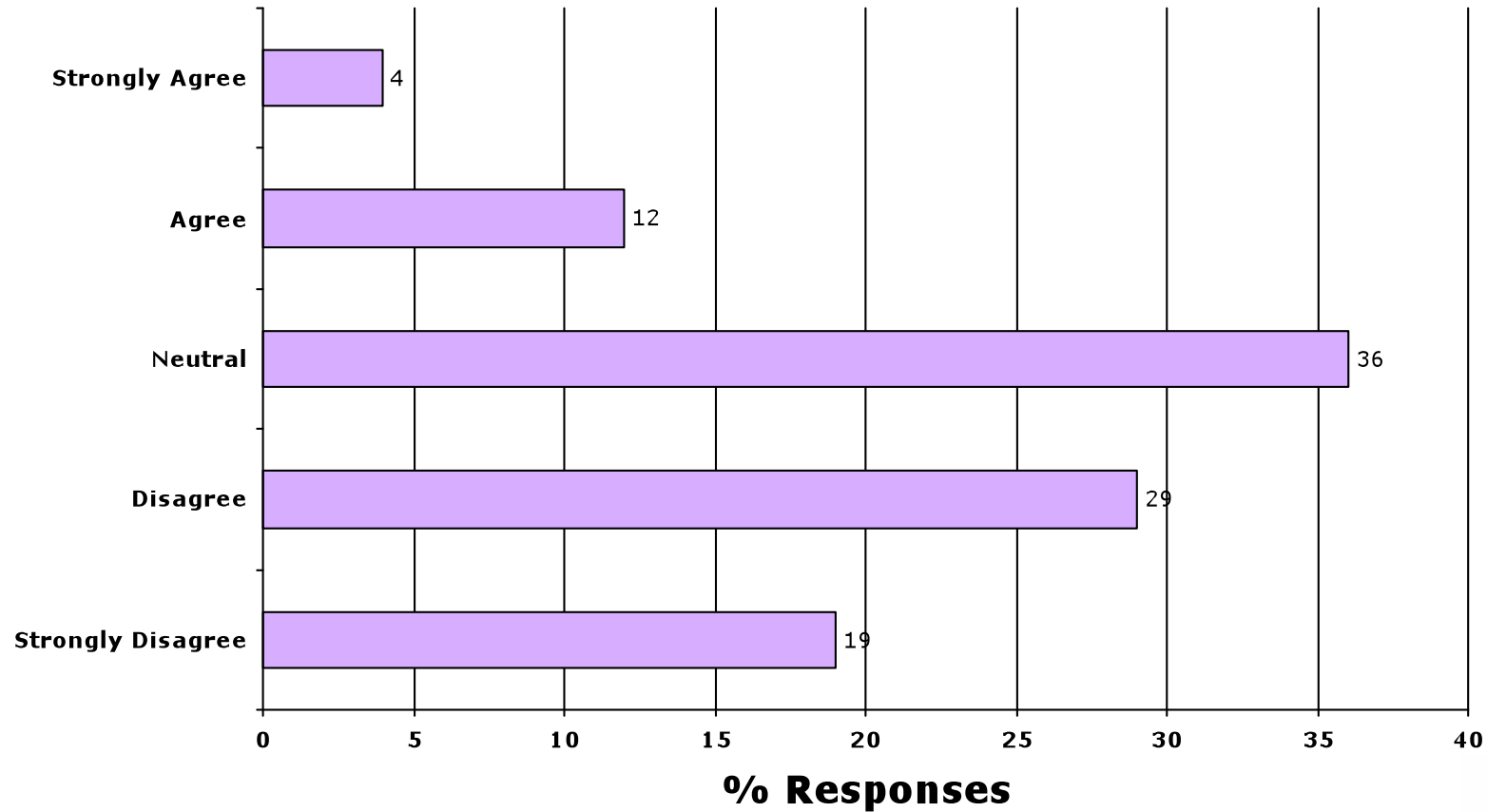
# In 2010 Pride should not co-ordinate a Winter Pride Festival week.



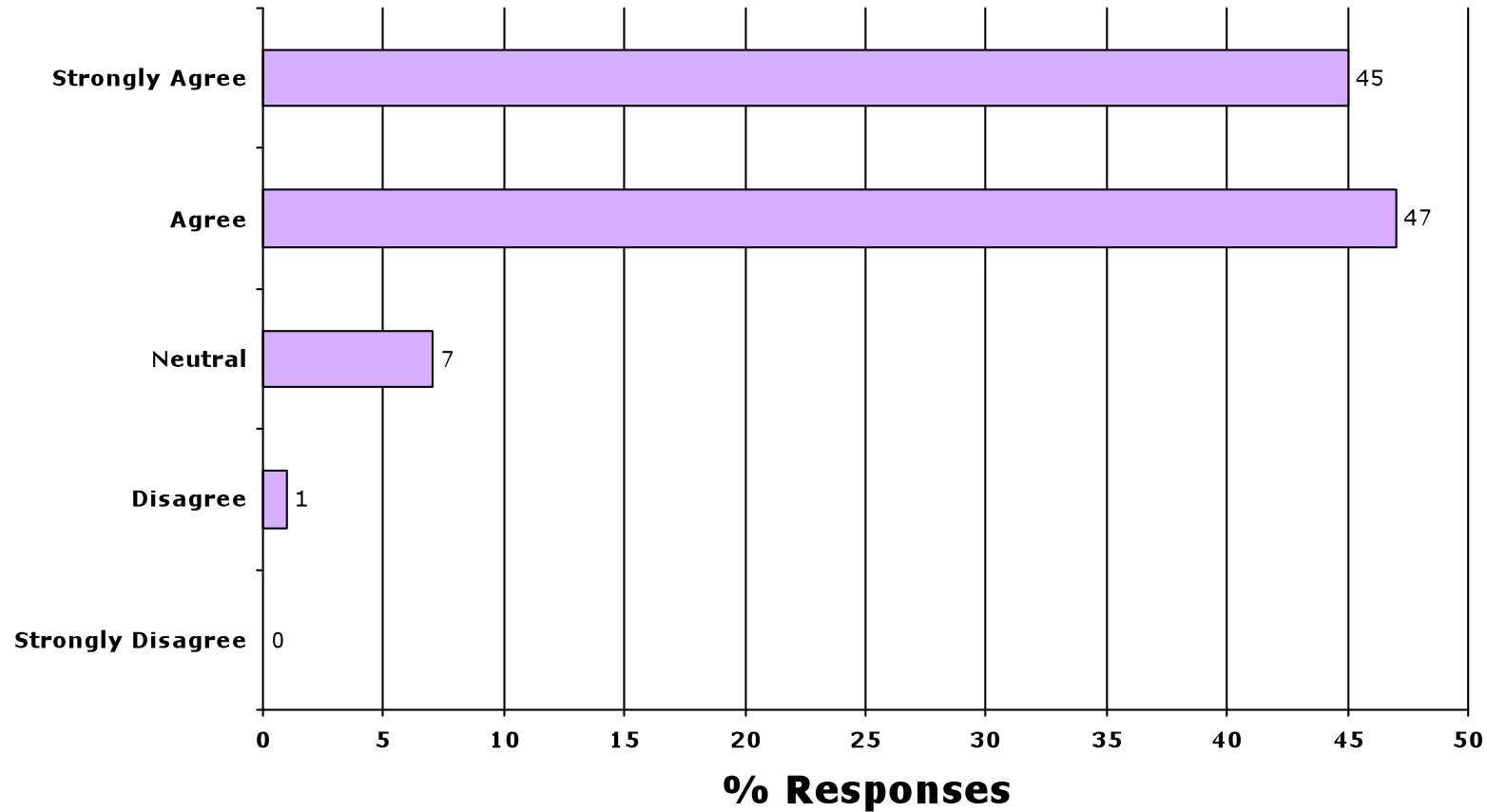
# Pride should provide expertise and in-kind support to LGBT community groups to put on events during the Summer Festival week, and to fundraise for their own cause.



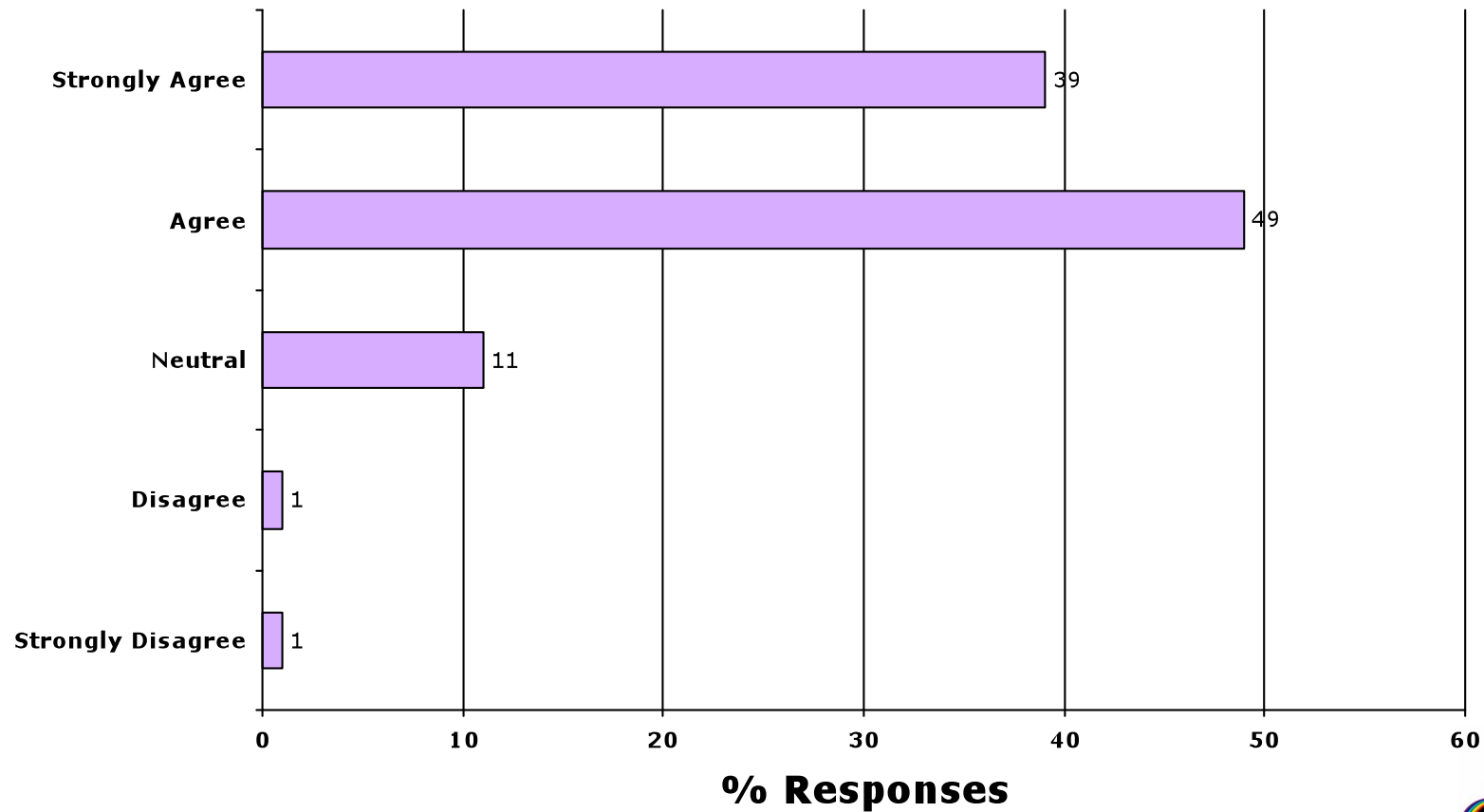
# In 2010 Pride will not provide financial support (as opposed to in-kind support) in the form of grants to LGBT community groups.



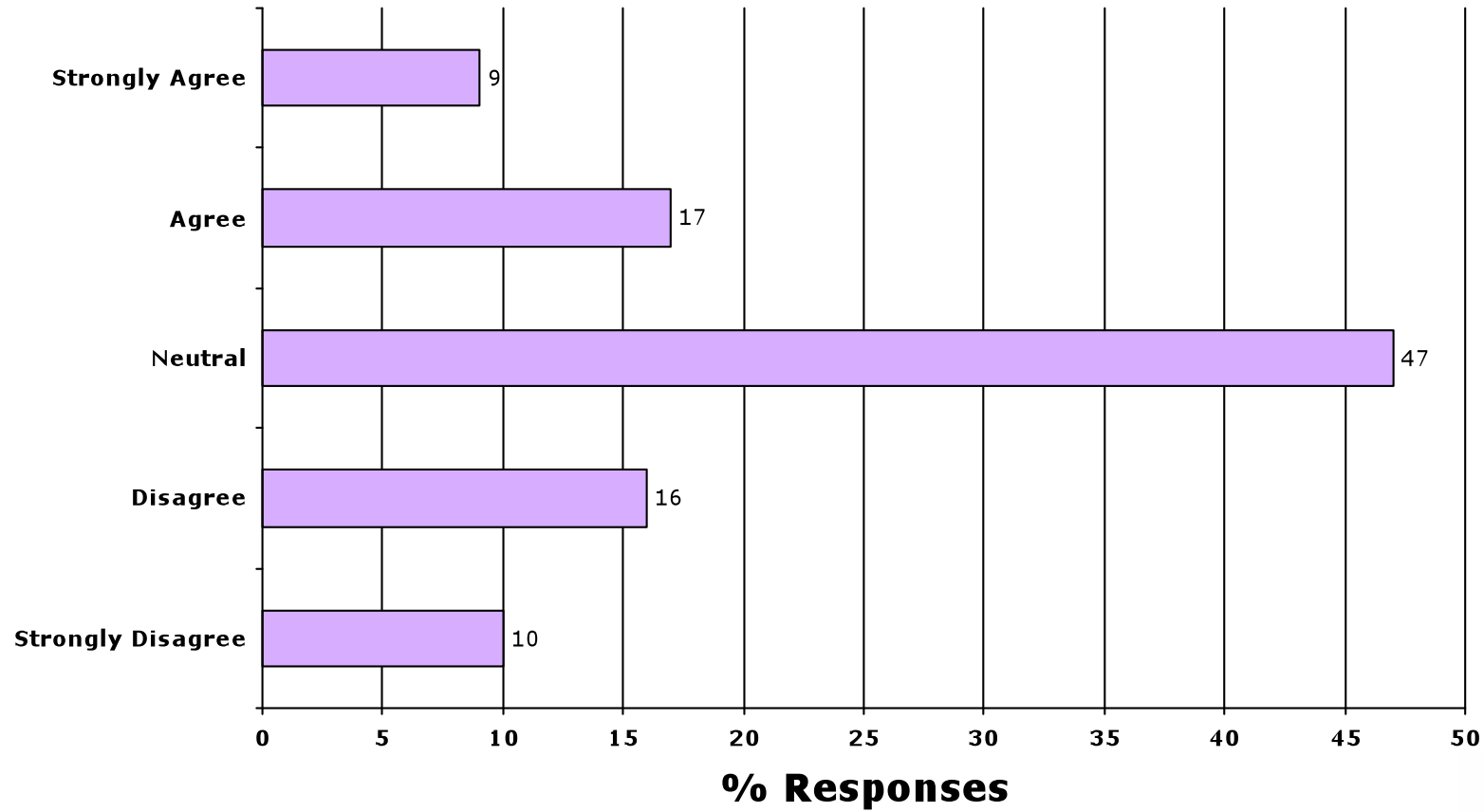
**Pride should seek to increase the number of people involved as volunteers, and actively recruit members who support the ethos and delivery of Pride's charitable objectives.**



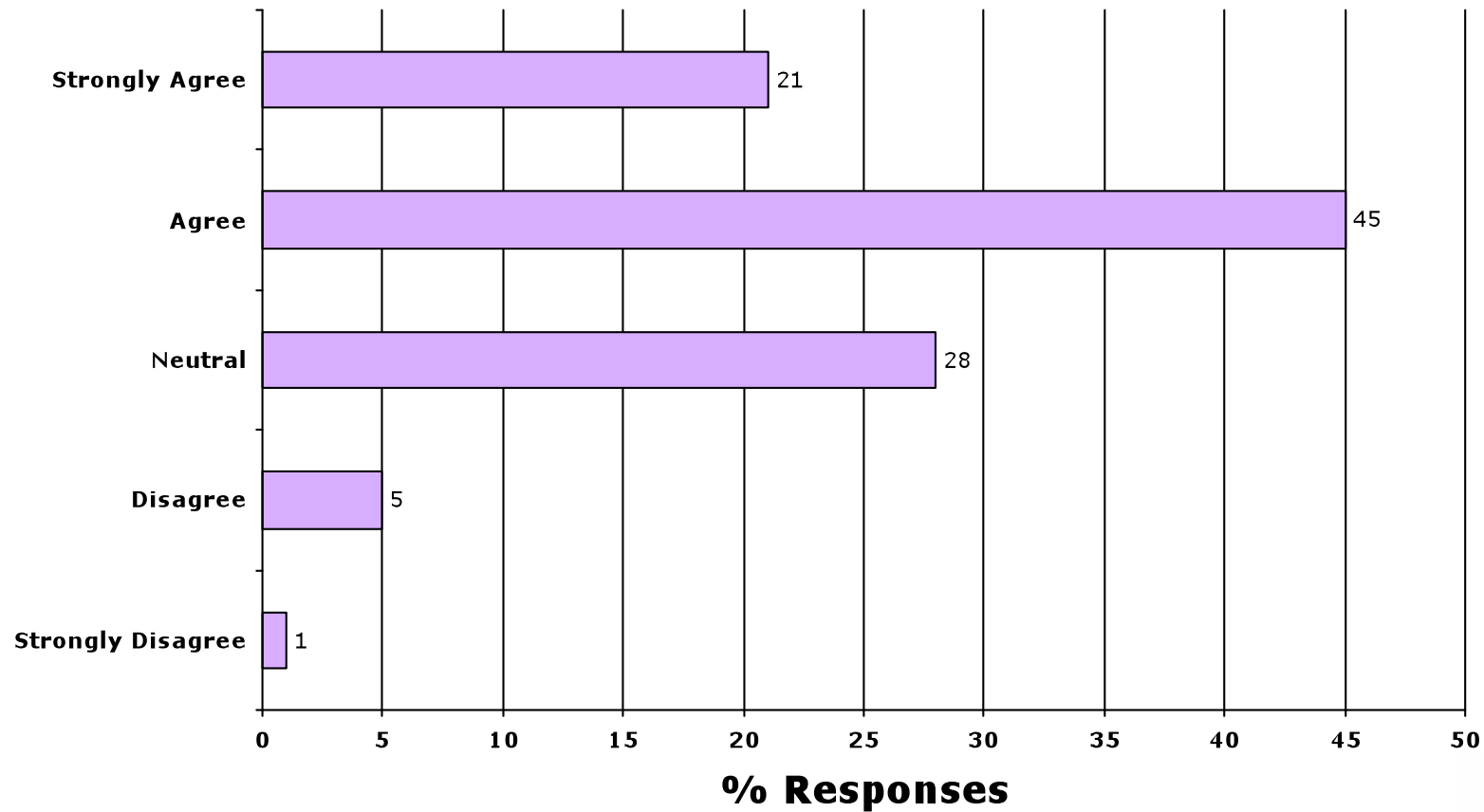
**Pride should continue to represent LGBT views, contribute to local working groups and provide representatives or speakers for events, where Pride has the appropriate knowledge or expertise to contribute to the issue, and it is relevant to Pride's charitable objectives.**



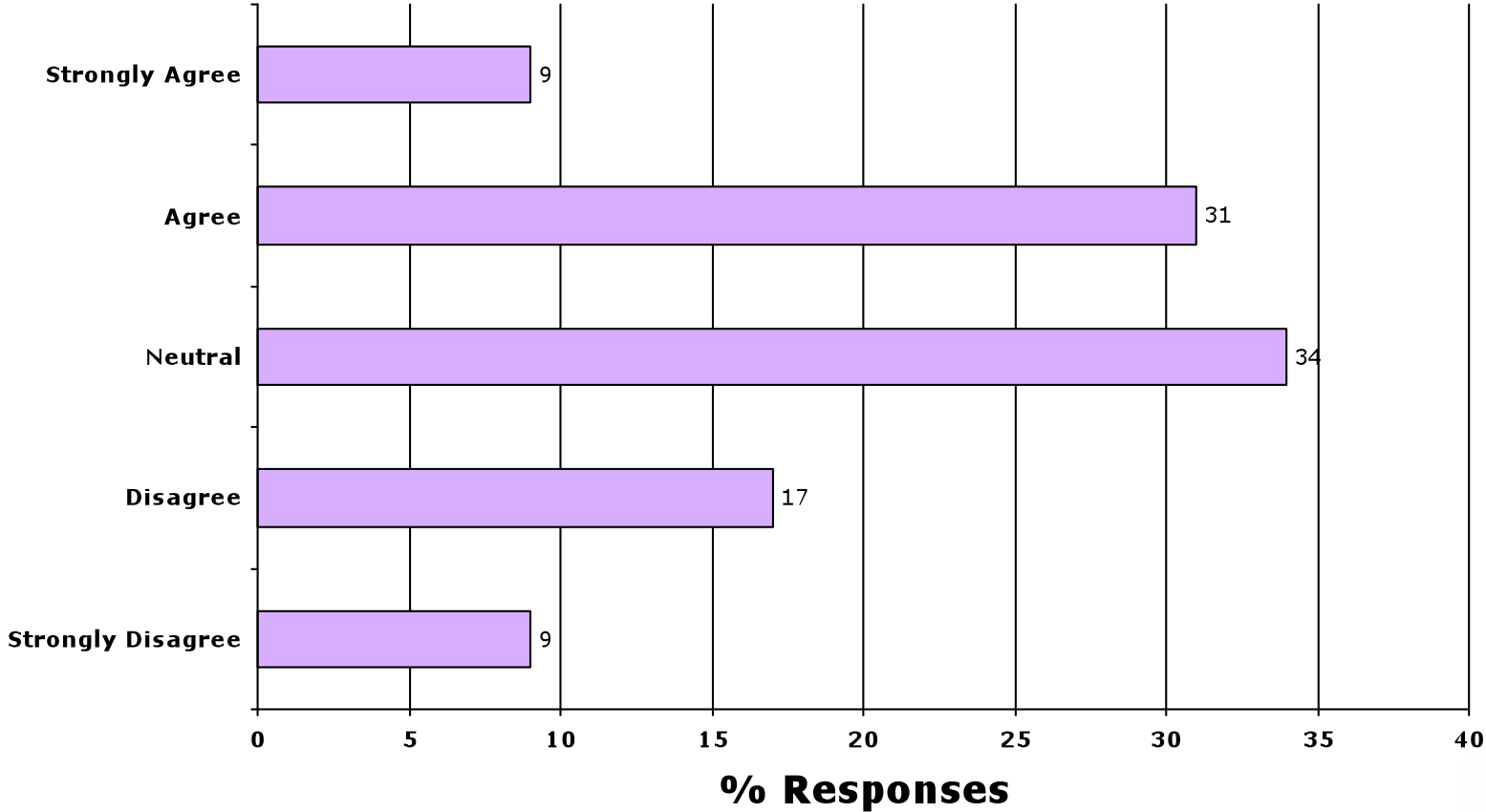
# Pride should continue to support the Companion Dog Show.



# Pride should focus support on one key event per month, either as a fundraiser for Pride, or in support of a local LGBT group, in association with partners.



# Pride should not attempt to support every fundraising event that may be held for Pride.
